Monthly Capital Campaign – The June capital campaign is for Rehoboth Christian School. RCS was founded in 1903 and will begin its 119th year of ministry to the Native American people in the Four Corners region. Their enrollment of around 415 students is represented by 75% Native American, 17% Caucasian, and 8% Hispanic, Asian and African American. Rehoboth is committed to building students up not only intellectually, but also spiritually and emotionally, helping them grow into mature Christians. Last school year, 78% of their students received tuition assistance due to low family income in the area. They rely on us, their ministry partners, to help provide this needed assistance each year.
