Monthly Capital Campaign – The January capital campaign is for Choices Clinic. Choices Clinic and Life Resource Center is a Christian ministry dedicated to preserving the value of human life by providing abortion alternatives, practical assistance, and education to the Cross Timbers area. All services are free and include pregnancy testing, STI testing and treatment, and limited ultrasound. Additionally, Choices offers classes on prenatal health, infant care, parenting, healthy relationships, Bible classes, and life skills. On Sunday, January 16th, there will be a representative visiting us and sharing more about Choice’s Clinic ministry. We will take the offering for Choices Clinic on January 23rd.

In 2021, Choices raised over \$41,000 at their 2 locations and from this campaign, our church contributed \$4,368.51.
