Monthly Capital Campaign – The February capital campaign is for The Pantry and More Inc. This ministry is a non-profit organization that offers food, clothing, and other items to those in a time of need. They are not government-funded and rely solely on clothing, food, and monetary donations. The Pantry is a blessing to our community as it gives people a place to come to when they are struggling financially or spiritually. As many know, the previous owner of The Pantry, Mr. Tommy Shelton passed away on October 26, 2018, after a short

battle with lung cancer. He opened the pantry with hopes that he would one day be able to provide food, clothing, and toys to those less fortunate and in need. His hopes and dreams became a reality in his time of operating the pantry which he gave all the honor and glory to God for its success. In his memory, the pantry has been kept open and will continue to do so with the support of the community of Stephenville and surrounding areas. Several expenses come with the operation of the Pantry including buying groceries to restock the shelves, paying a monthly electric bill so that the refrigerators will stay on and cool for perishable items, and paying fuel costs when traveling to food banks to buy more groceries. Isabel Talamantes will be visiting us on Sunday, February 20th and we will take our offering for The Pantry on the 27th.

Choices Clinic “Change for Life” Campaign – This campaign is one of the many ways we support Choices Clinic and Life Resource Center. Choices Clinic is located in Stephenville and Graham and is a Christian ministry dedicated to preserving the value of human life by providing abortion alternatives, practical assistance, and education to the Cross Timbers area. If you have not already, we have baby bottles located on the church foyer table for you to pick up. Please take this bottle home and place it in a visible area and over the next 2 weeks drop in your loose change, bills, or checks. On Sunday, February 27th, please return the bottle to church. This fundraiser shows how one penny may not be much alone, but when put with others it can accomplish many great things! In 2021, Choices raised over \$41,000 at their 2 locations and our church contributed \$4,368.51.
