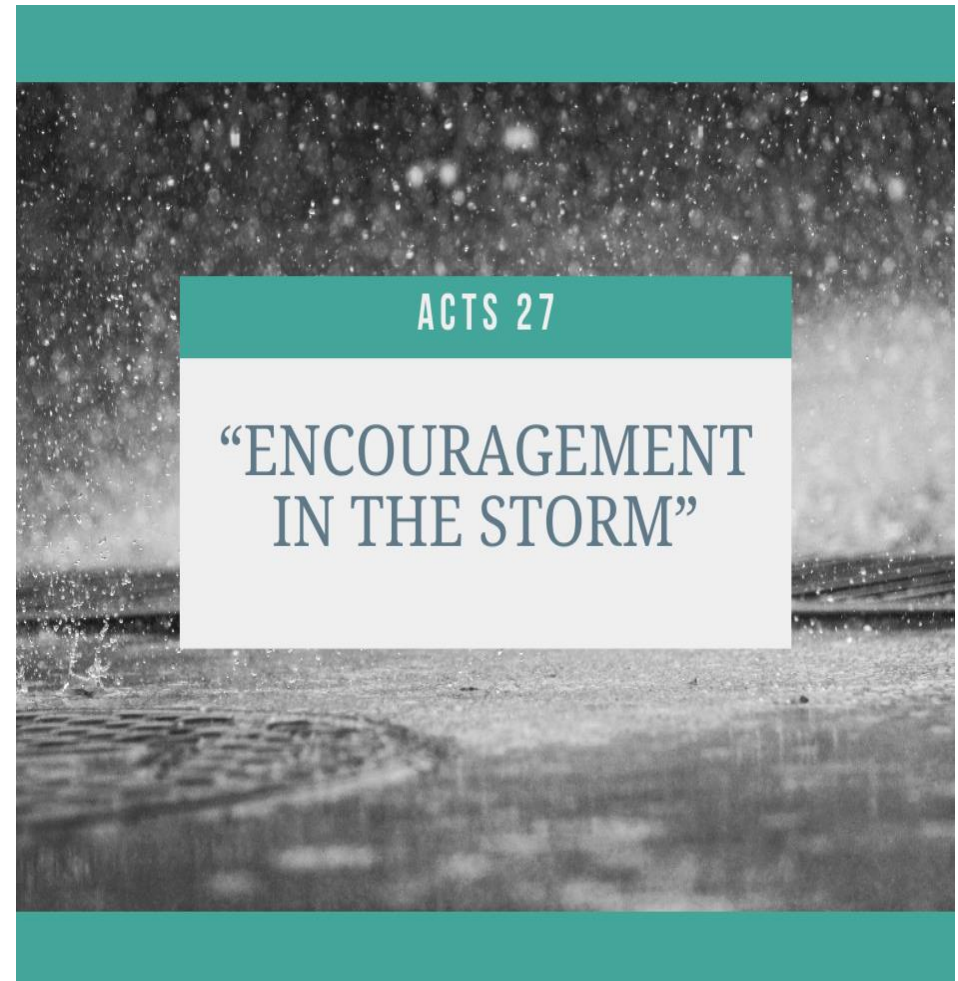


**\*Prayer Requests:**
