Monthly Capital Campaign – The March Capital Campaign is for the Sunrise Homeless Navigation Center in Austin, Texas. The Sunrise Homeless Navigation Center is a recognized leader in innovative solutions to the homeless epidemic in Austin. Sunrise pioneers’ new collaborations between faith communities, public institutions, non-profits, and local government that not only view humanitarian aid as a moral imperative but a key strategy in housing individuals experiencing homelessness. Since

its start six years ago, Sunrise has housed over 500 homeless clients. Along with equipping homeless individuals for long-term success, Sunrise offers a variety of humanitarian and health care services. Over 1,100 homeless clients receive mail at Sunrise allowing them the opportunity to receive food stamps, social security, and safe keep important documents. Additionally, Sunrise offers the only free physical and mental health walk-in clinic in Austin for homeless clients to receive medical/prescription coverage, dental, optical, and more. Sunrise is committed to living out Jesus’ love, serving marginalized communities above & beyond expectation. We will take our offering for the Homeless Navigation Center this morning.

Profession of Faith Class – Pastor Greg will be holding a profession of faith class in the coming months. If you are interested in becoming a professing member of Stephenville CRC, we’d love to have you join our class. Please let Pastor Greg know and he will start planning the date of the first class.
