**Monthly Capital Campaign** – The May capital campaign is for the World Renew Ukraine Refugee Aid. World Renew is currently working with their global networks in the region to respond to the needs of vulnerable families impacted by the conflict in Ukraine. They are supporting their peer organizations by providing essential items for people fleeing for safety to neighboring countries. In Slovakia, they are providing temporary shelters, emergency food, and emergency non-food items such as blankets, linens, mattresses, and basic hygiene items. In Romania and Poland, they are responding with health support by supplying health packs that will be used by local health centers. World Renew continues to support their networks as they answer God’s call to extend love and hope to the many people left vulnerable by this conflict. We will take our offering in support of this ministry next Sunday, May 22<sup>nd</sup>.

**Profession of Faith Class** – Pastor Greg will be holding a profession of faith class in the coming months.
