


***Prayer Requests:**

Monthly Capital Campaign – The February capital campaign is for World Renew Disaster Response Services. World Renew is a non-profit organization that provides clean up, rebuilding, needs assessments and long-term recovery services, free of charge, to disaster survivors in North America. World Renew DRS works with local community organizations in disaster areas to help homeowners rebuild their houses and lives. With over 50 years of experience, they provide communities that have experienced a disaster with long-term recovery work that may be requested over the next one to three years or longer. They specialize in assisting vulnerable homeowners in disaster areas with services such as home reconstruction

and rebuilding, roof repair, needs assessments, and cost estimating. We will take the offering for World Renew DRS on Sunday, February 22nd.
