Stephenville and works with many other churches/non-profit groups in Erath County to help those in need in our community. This ministry provides food monthly financial assistance (rent, utility bills, prescriptions, etc.) once every seven months, clothing every three months, fans or heaters when available, and school supplies. We currently give \$50 to each Grace Place client who requests assistance with a maximum of 15 clients per month. So far this year, we have assisted 45 Grace Place clients totaling \$2,250. This will be our first benevolence offering for 2026.

**Small Group Leadership Class** – Pastor Draayer will be offering another small group leadership training class today at 6:00pm in the council room.

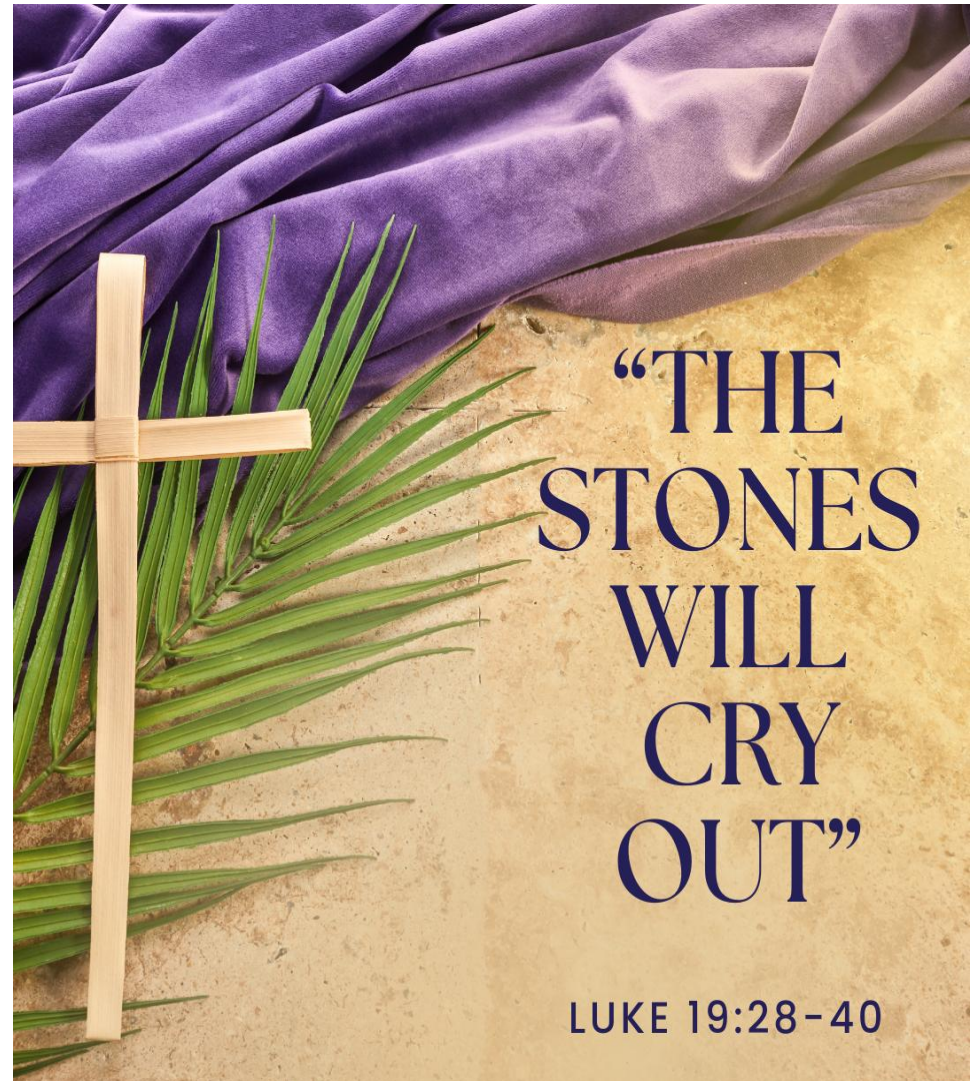
### **\*Upcoming Dates to Remember:**
