- For Trinity Wright who will have an MRI done to rule out a possible brain tumor due to a swollen pituitary gland.

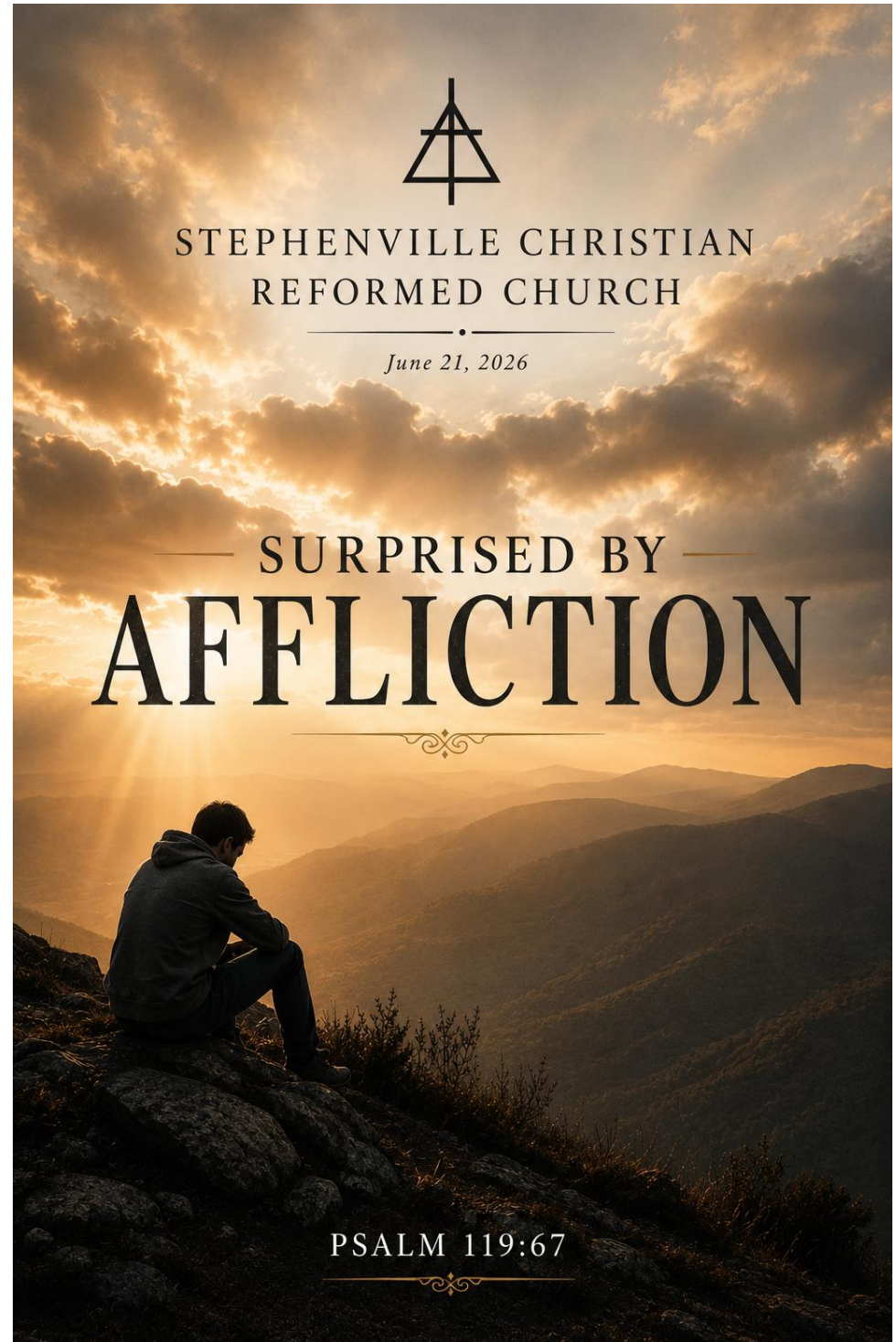
