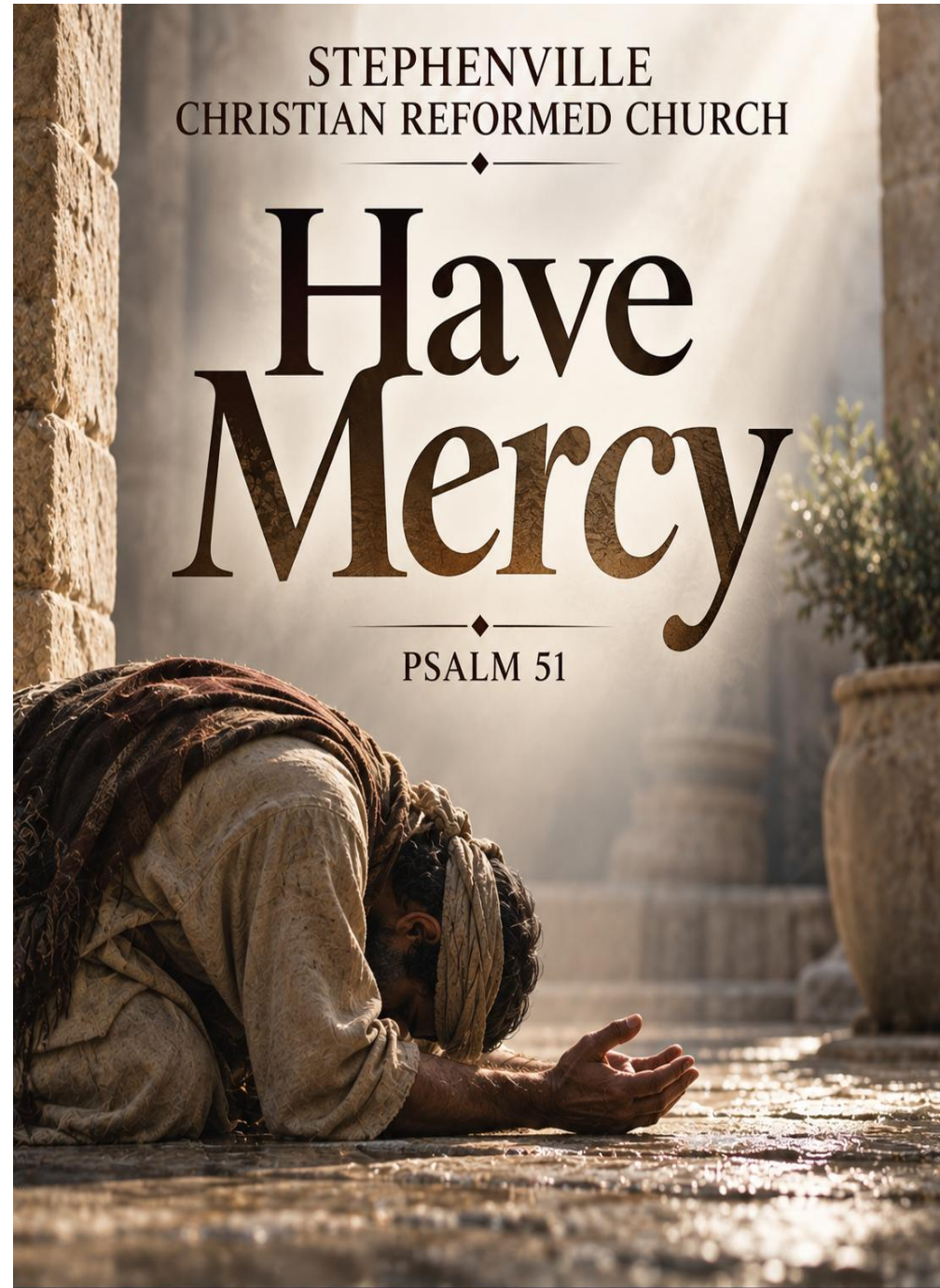
***Prayer Requests:**
