## **\*Upcoming Dates to Remember:**

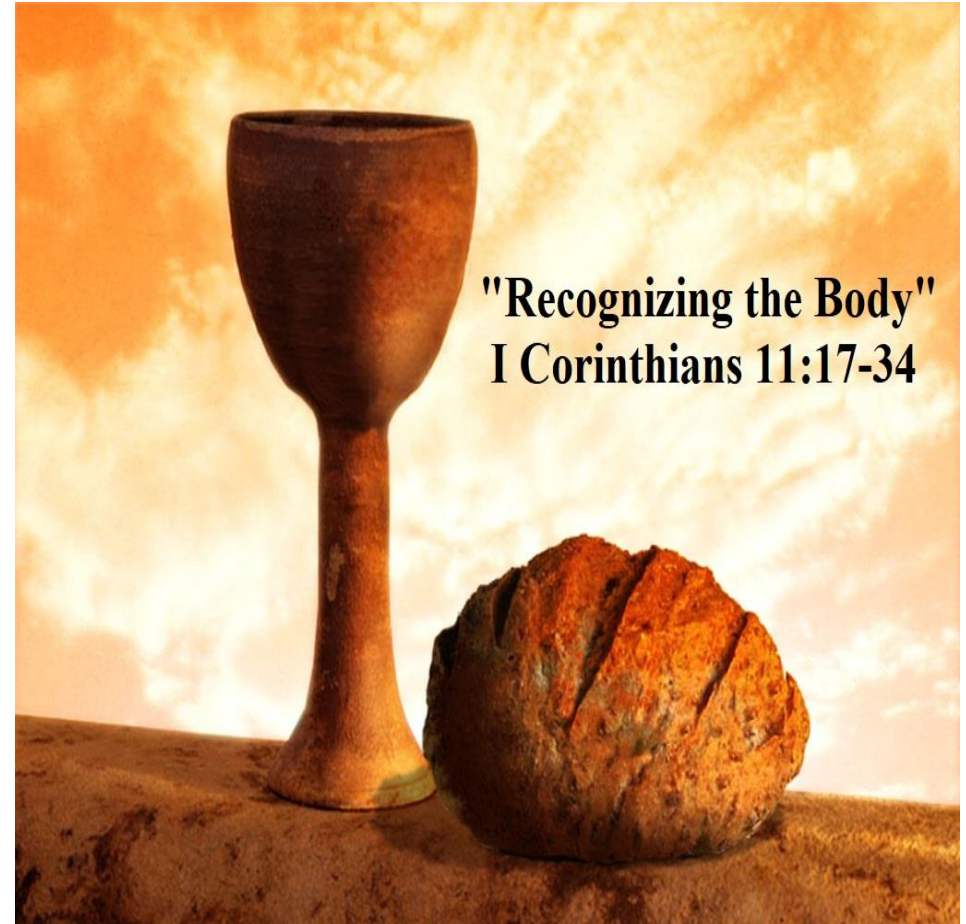
**Reformation Sunday** – Next Sunday, October 30<sup>th</sup>, we will be celebrating Reformation Sunday.

**Monthly Capital Campaign** – The October capital campaign is for Tent Schools International. Tent Schools International comes alongside Christian leaders in refugee camps and other transitional areas to establish educational opportunities for children fleeing war, persecution and natural disaster. Non-governmental organizations (NGOs) supply food, water, and basic shelter, but most children seeking refuge do not have the opportunity to attend school. Temporary learning structures, technology, and resources for teachers are the most efficient, effective ways to bring education to displaced children, equipping them with the skills they need for life outside the camps.
