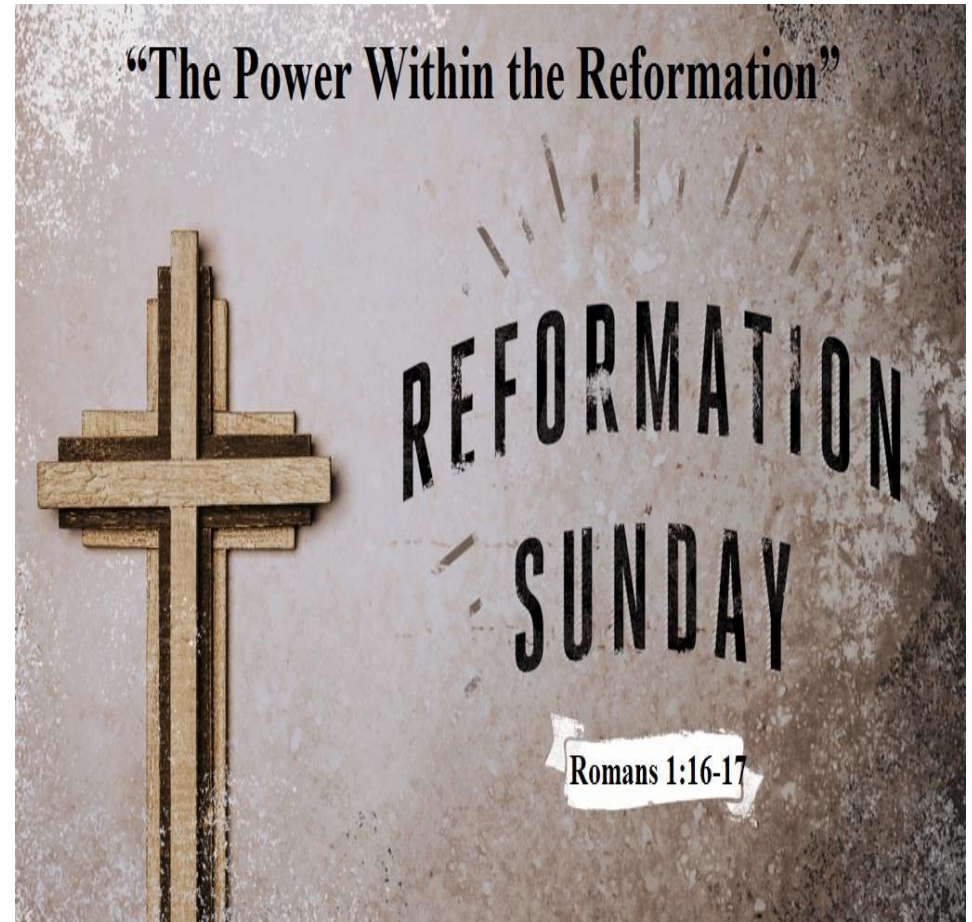


**\*Prayer Requests:**

**5<sup>th</sup> Sunday Benevolence Offering** – This morning, we will take a benevolence offering. These offerings are used for any benevolence needs our deacons come across including but not limited to our support to Grace Place Ministries in Stephenville. Grace Place is a ministry of First Baptist Church of Stephenville, and they work with many other churches/non-profit groups in Erath County to help those in need in our community. This ministry provides food monthly, financial assistance (rent; utility bills, prescriptions, etc.) once every seven months, clothing every three months, fans or heaters when available, and school

supplies. We have a great need in Stephenville and your donations help to aid those in need in our community and who seek out help through Grace Place Ministries. So far in 2022, we have assisted 165 Grace Place clients totaling \$5,590.00
