In 2022, we assisted 193 Grace Place clients totaling \$6,420 in benevolence cases. So far in 2023, we have assisted 15 clients totaling \$450.

Choices Clinic “Change for Life” Campaign – This campaign is one of many ways that we support Choices Clinic & Life Resource Center and their pro-life ministry. Choices Clinic & Life Resource Center is located in Stephenville and in Graham, and it is a Christian ministry dedicated to preserving the value of human life by providing abortion alternatives, practical assistance, and education to the Cross Timbers area. If you haven’t already, please pick up a bottle located in the foyer and place it in a visible area and over the next few weeks drop in your loose change. On Sunday, March 5th, please return the bottle to church. This fundraiser shows how one penny may not be much alone, but when put with many others it can accomplish many great things! In 2022, Choices raised over \$39,000 at their 2 locations and our church contributed \$4,126.73 towards that total.
