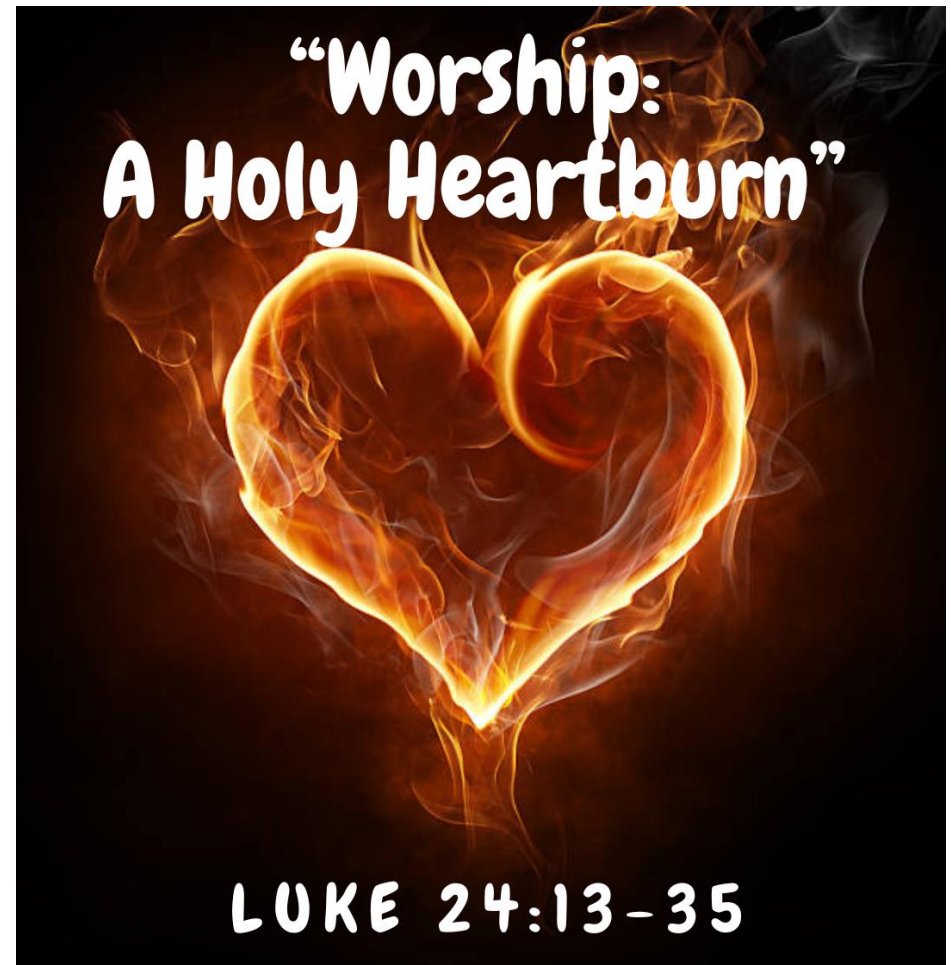


***Prayer Requests:**

*News/Reminders:

5th Sunday Benevolence Offering – This morning, our second offering will be for our benevolence fund. These offerings are used for any benevolence needs our deacons come across including but not limited to our support to Grace Place Ministries in Stephenville. Grace Place is a ministry of First Baptist Church of Stephenville and works with many other churches/non-profit groups in Erath County to help those in need in our community. This ministry provides food monthly, financial assistance (rent; utility bills, prescriptions, etc.) once every seven months, clothing every three months, fans or heaters when available, and school supplies. In 2022, we assisted 193 Grace Place clients totaling \$6,420 in benevolence cases. So far in 2023, we have assisted 53 clients totaling \$1,580 and have received \$1,278 in benevolence offerings.
