*News/Reminders:

Monthly Capital Campaign – The June capital campaign is for Rehoboth Christian School. RCS began in 1903 as a mission post to reach Native Americans with the Gospel. The ministry continues through Christian education with a student population that is 79% Native American. Our current K-12 program serves 426 students with an additional 52 students in Pre-K. Our tuition assistance program provides support to 76% of our students at an average of \$3,593 per student. Our total annual need is \$1,862,500. After a few abnormal school years, we are thankful to have all 41 of our HS Seniors graduate with 88% planning to attend a 2/4 year college or trade school. Six students plan to continue
