**Monthly Capital Campaign** – The June capital campaign is for Rehoboth Christian School. RCS was founded in 1903 and will begin its 121<sup>st</sup> year of ministry to the Native American people in the Four Corners region. Their enrollment of around 415 students is represented by 75% Native American, 17% Caucasian, and 8% Hispanic, Asian and African American. RCS is committed to building students up not only intellectually, but also spiritually and emotionally, helping them grow into mature Christians. Last school year, 78% of their students received tuition assistance due to low family income in the area. They rely on their ministry partners to help provide this needed assistance each year.
