Monthly Communion – We will be celebrating communion on the 5th Sunday, July 30th, instead of July 23rd due to Pastor Greg being on vacation.

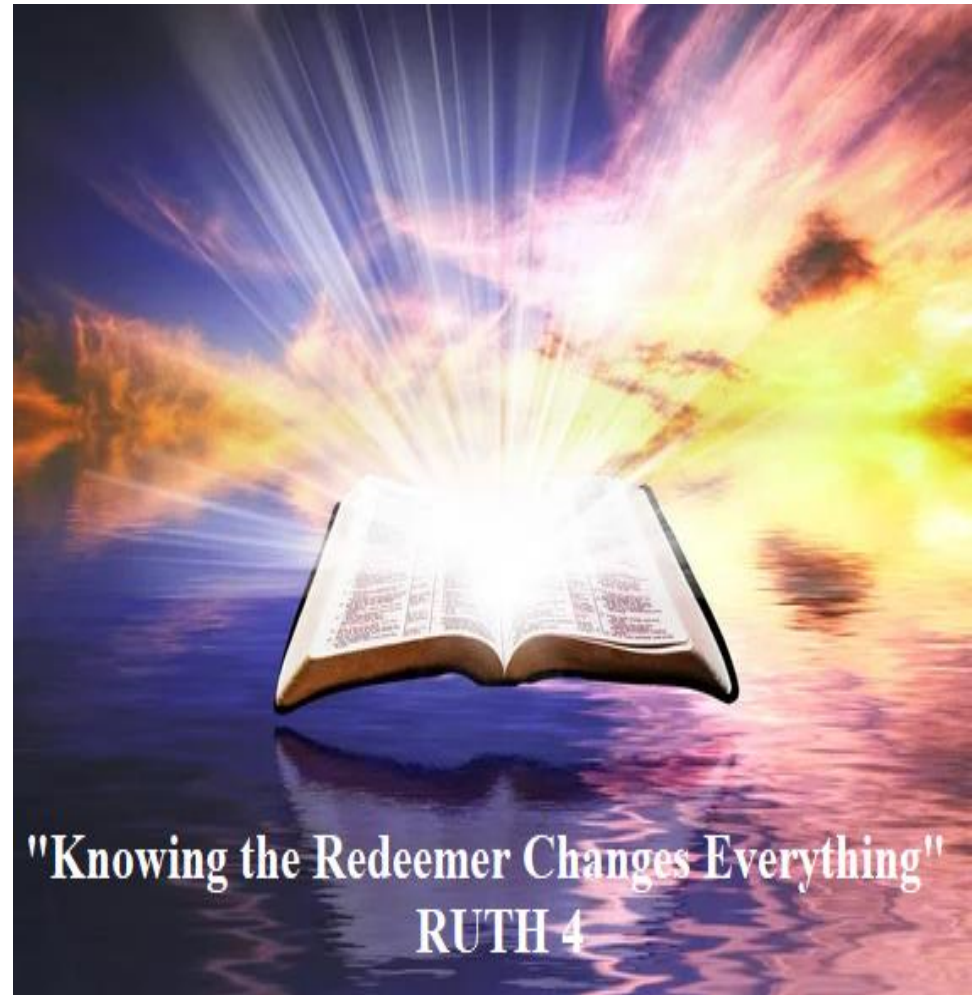
