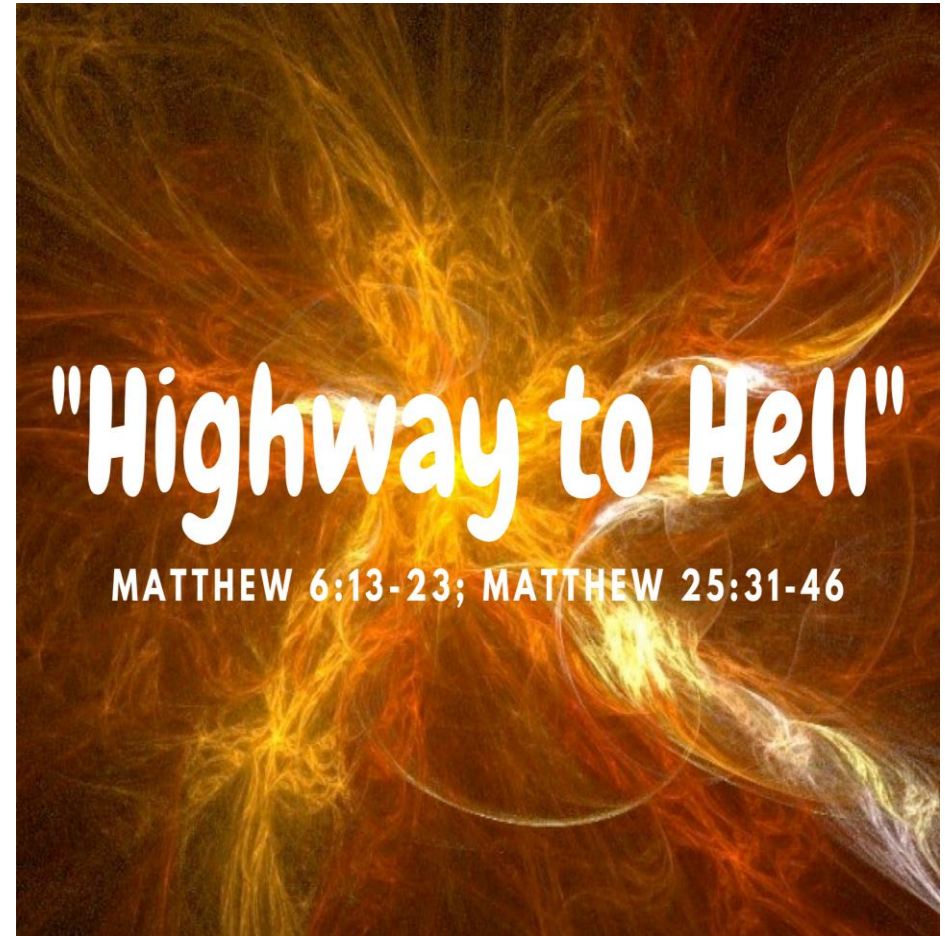
**Sunday School** – Sunday School will begin following morning worship on August 27<sup>th</sup> and there are classes for Pre-K 3 to adults.

**Monthly Capital Campaign** – The August capital campaign is for Backpack Buddies of Erath County. They are a local, non-profit organization that provides children from food-insecure homes with healthy weekend meals during the school year. School principals and guidance counselors select the children. On Fridays, the backpacks are prepared and delivered to Stephenville ISD and the program has now expanded to include Dublin, Lingleville, Huckabay, Morgan Mill, Bluff Dale, and 3-Way ISD. In the 2022-2023 school year, they served over 300 students in Erath County. The average cost to feed 1 child per weekend is \$5.00. For 6 weeks is \$30.00, per semester is \$90.00, and per school year is \$180.00.
