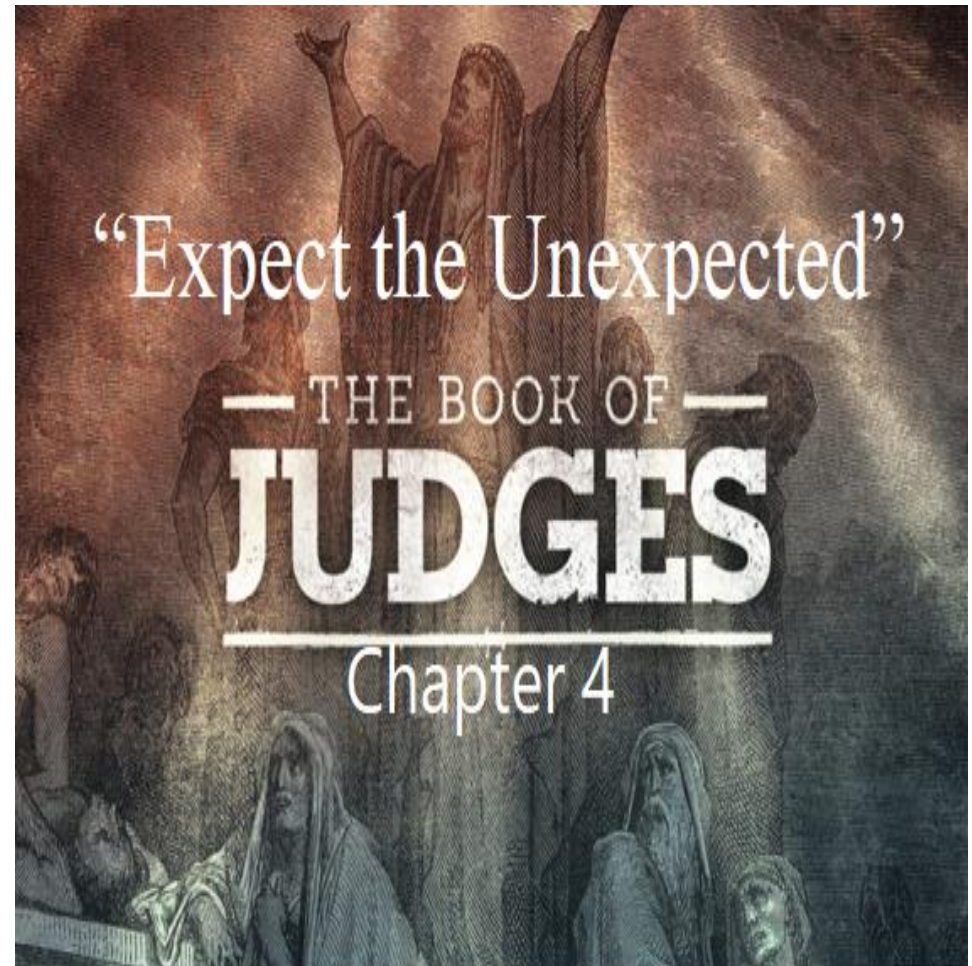


**\*Prayer Requests:**

**Monthly Capital Campaign** – The February capital campaign is for Luke Society. The Luke Society is a Christian ministry that works internationally with indigenous medical professionals to bring healing and hope through Jesus Christ. They support and empower nationals as they serve the Lord among their own people, language and culture, and in doing so, carrying out the Great Commission in Matthew 28 to “go and make disciples of all nations.” The Luke Society is rooted in a steadfast philosophy that in order to transform lives they must first equip visionaries who have God-given passions and desires to improve their own communities. They do not do the

work for them, nor do they seek to direct their passions or visions. They come alongside ministries as a family, developing long-term relationships of mentoring, networking and encouragement.
