Monthly Capital Campaign – The June capital campaign is for the Brady Miller Benefit. Brady was born on March 4th and after many medical procedures, the doctors determined he had a very rare benign tumor known as a neuromuscular choristoma on his face which impacts his airway and facial bones. Brady has been under the care of many medical specialists including an oncologist, cardiologist, geneticist, endocrinologist, audiologist and an ENT specialist. This has created many financial setbacks for the Miller family which we hope to help them out with for our offering this morning. This week we received an update from Emily Miller, Brady's mother: "Hello everyone, we are incredibly grateful for the overwhelming love and support for our precious little one. Unfortunately, things didn't go as planned today, but we feel fortunate that Brady has an exceptional oncologist, and we are thankful to be back home. The news is that the neuromuscular choristoma (mass or tumor) in Brady's cheek is growing. This tumor has been classified as benign, but we've learned that even benign tumors can grow. Fortunately, it's growing slowly, and Brady's oncologist has outlined a plan of action. Today, we received medication that Brady will start taking tomorrow. If his body responds well to the medication, we won't have to go for another MRI for two months."
