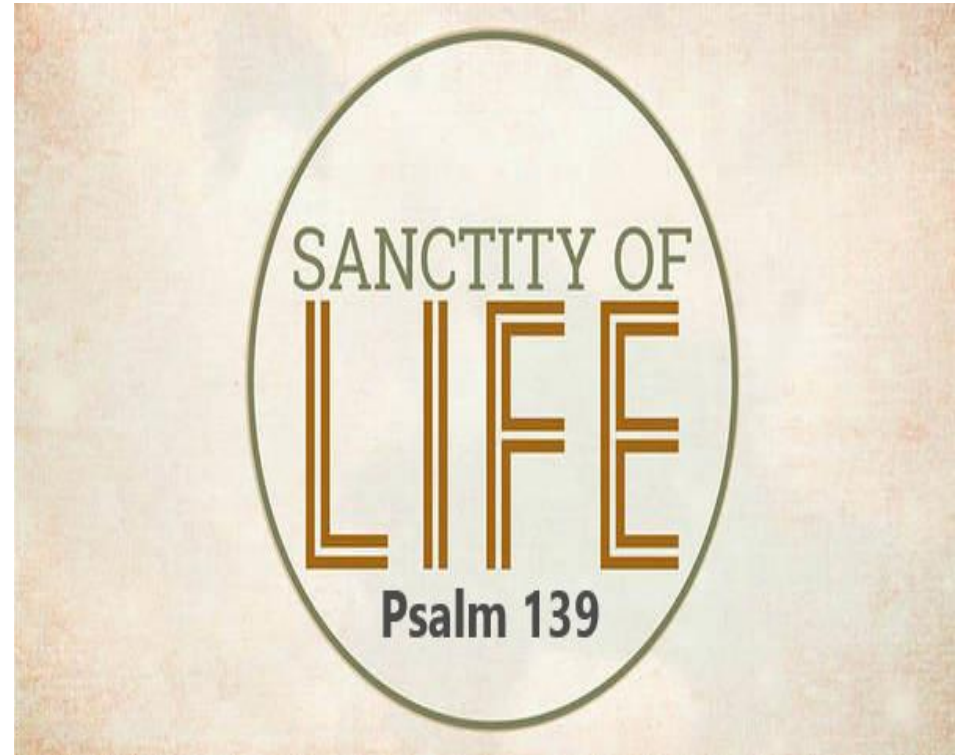


***Prayer Requests:**
