## \*News/Reminders:

**Monthly Capital Campaign** – The October capital campaign is for World Renew Disaster Response Services. World Renew DRS is coordinating with officials and other voluntary organizations in response to Hurricane Milton, which followed on the heels of Hurricane Helene which hit Florida’s Big Bend region this past week. World Renew is preparing to assist with needs from Hurricane Milton even as they are adding Hurricane Helene to their existing work in Sarasota, Florida, following Hurricane Debby in August 2024. They are making plans to offer clean-up, repair, and reconstruction services to homeowners affected by destruction from these recent storms. Their regional managers in Florida are coordinating with their partners to mobilize volunteer clean-up teams in the next two to three weeks. We will take our offering in support of this ministry on Sunday, October 27<sup>th</sup>.
