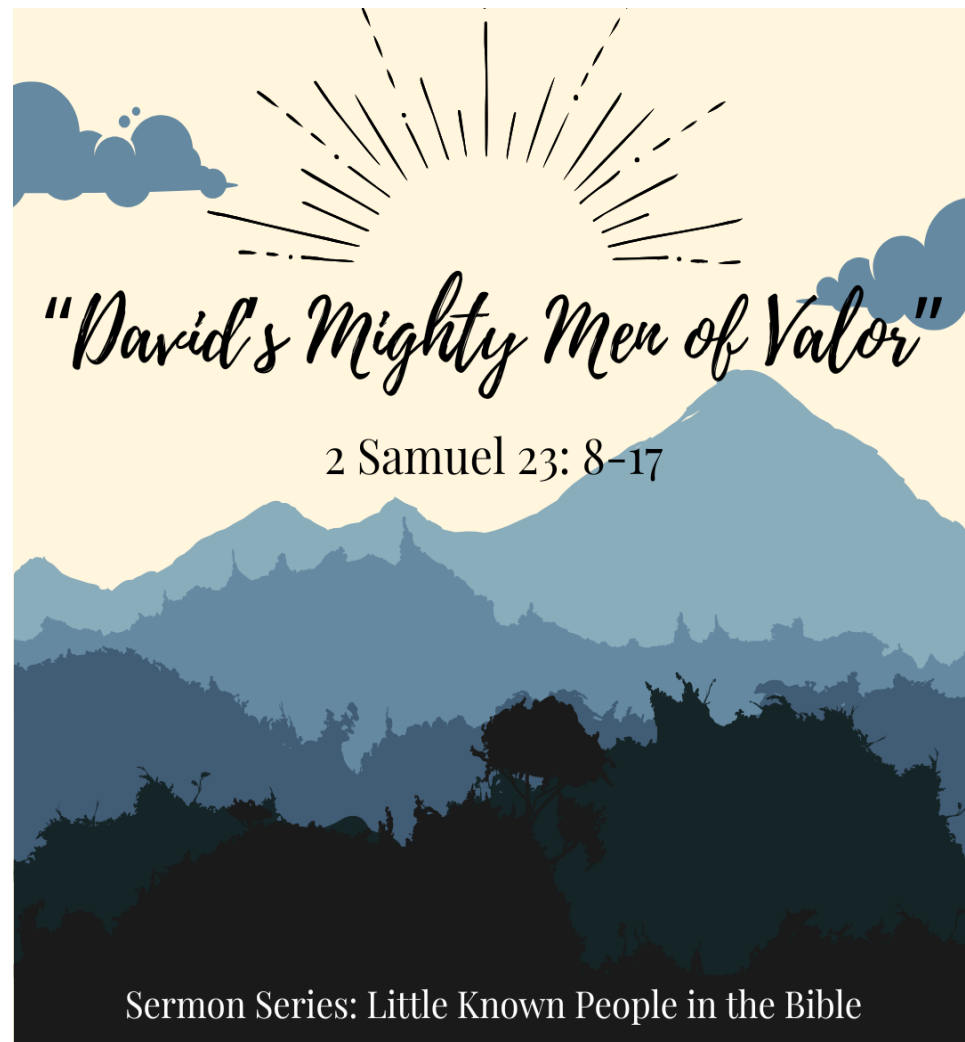
Valentine's Dinner – Mark your calendars for our annual Valentine's Dinner on Saturday, February 15th at 6:30 pm here at Stephenville CRC.
