Monthly Capital Campaign – The March capital campaign is for the Brady Miller Benefit. Brady was born on March 4th, 2024, with a very rare benign tumor known as a neuromuscular choristoma on his face which after a few months was beginning to impact his airway and facial bones. After many months and treatments, the doctors were hopeful that the tumor would continue to stay benign and was not growing. In the middle of February, his mother Emily shared that Brady had been struggling with breathing and the doctors found out that Brady's tumor had turned malignant, and he had been diagnosed with Rhabdomyosarcoma. This month he had a tracheotomy, G-tube insertion, Port placement, Lumbar puncture, and a Spinal tap and is currently getting chemotherapy treatments in the hospital through the middle of March. This has created many financial setbacks for the Miller family as Brady's father Tate has taken time off work to be with Brady in the hospital. We will take our offering in support of the Miller family next Sunday, March 23rd.
