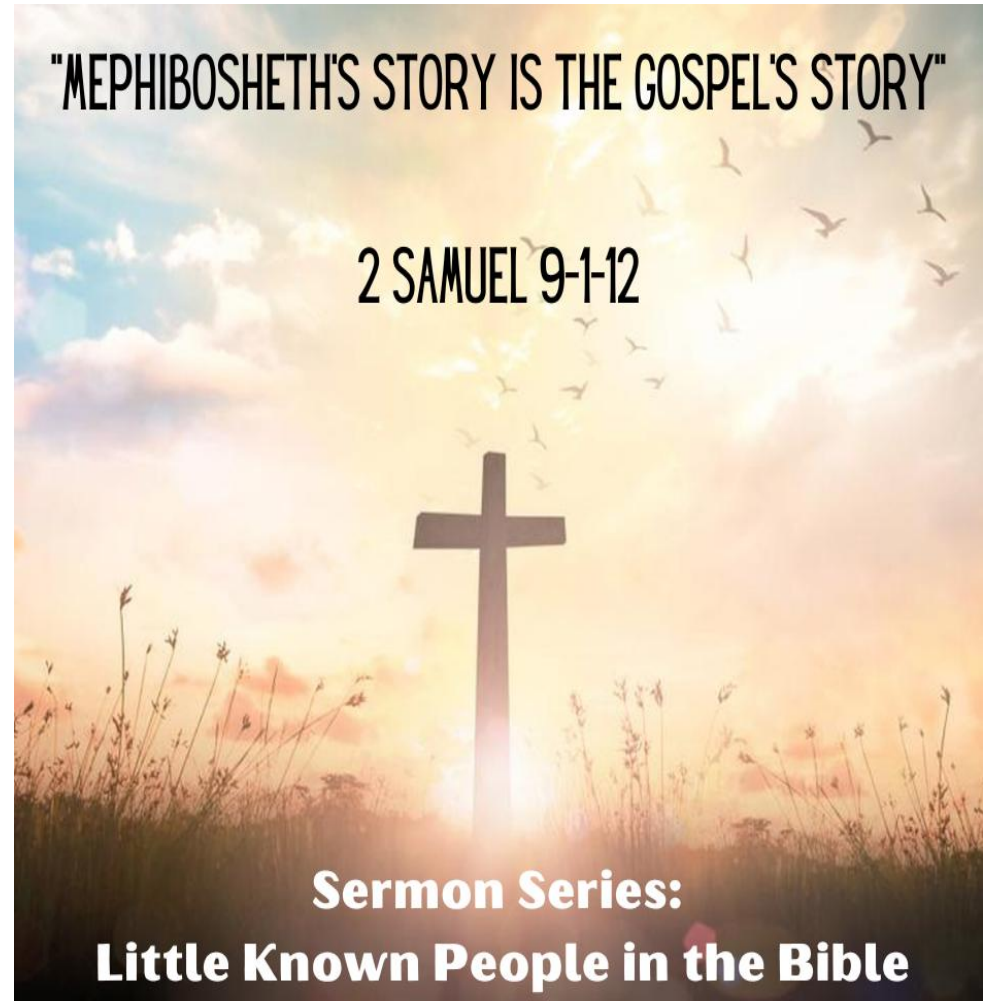
Spring Break – Spring Break is the week of March 16th through the 22nd. We will not have Sunday School on the 16th or Wednesday Family Night on the 19th.

Monthly Capital Campaign – The March capital campaign is for the Brady Miller Benefit. Brady was born on March 4th, 2024, with a very rare benign tumor known as a neuromuscular choristoma on his face which after a few months was beginning to impact his airway and facial bones. After many months and treatments, the doctors were hopeful that the tumor would continue to stay benign and was not growing. In the middle of February, his mother Emily shared that Brady had been struggling with breathing and the doctors found out that Brady’s tumor had turned malignant, and he had been diagnosed with Rhabdomyosarcoma. This month he had a tracheotomy, G-tube insertion, Port placement, Lumbar puncture, and a Spinal tap and is currently
