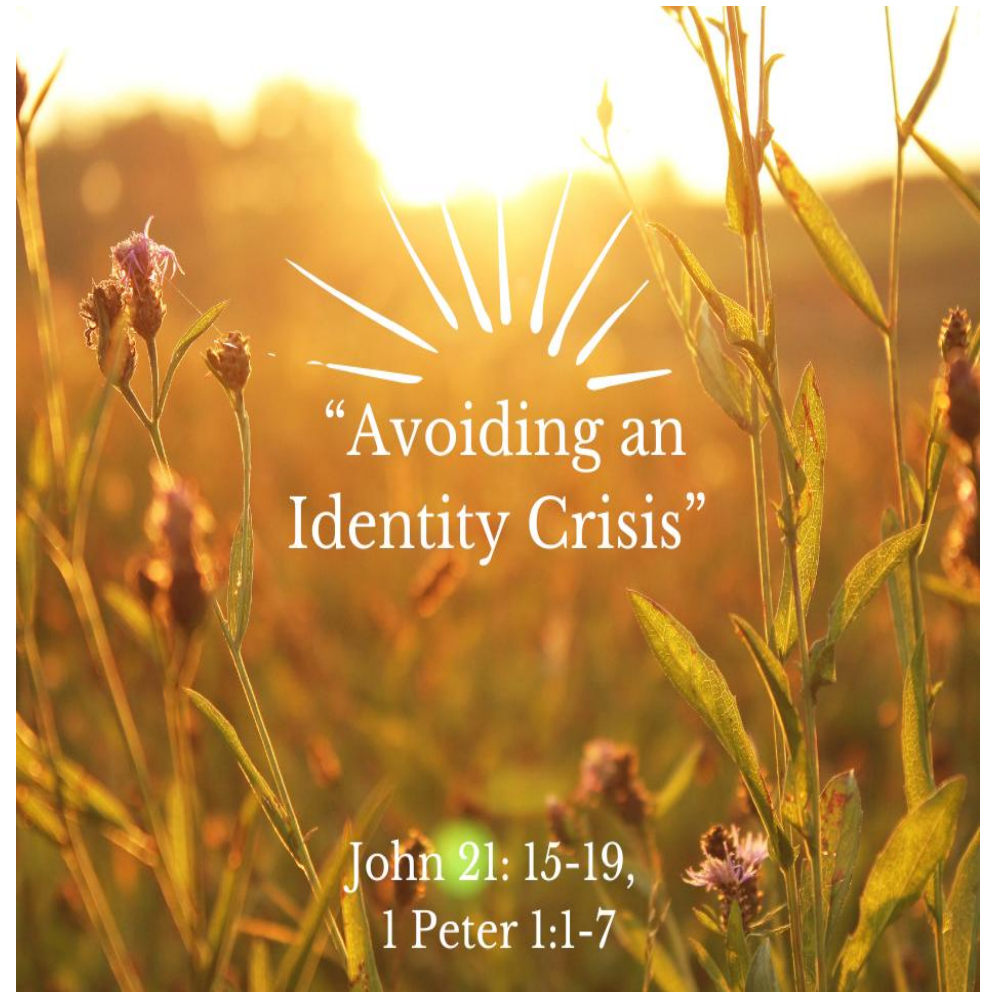
Senior Sunday – On May 25th we will have a special service where we will recognize our graduating senior Kaleb Osinga.
